Housing Authority of Thurston County's Foster Youth to Independence (FYI) Program

Foster Youth to Independence (FYI) vouchers provide dedicated rental assistance to support youth in two situations: youth exiting foster care who are at risk of homelessness, and youth who have become homeless (or at risk of homelessness after having been in foster care).

To qualify for the program, an individual must be between the ages of 18-24 (have not reached their 25th birthday), must have been in foster care between the ages of 16 and 18 years of age, and be homeless or at risk of homelessness.

The Housing Authority of Thurston County partners with Olive Crest, an FYI housing support provider, in the administration of the FYI program.
